

Information on Data Processing in the Context of Participation in the Campaign

1. Data Controller

The personal data controller is Panek S.A., Grójecka Street 208, 02-390 Warsaw (hereinafter referred to as "Data Controller" or "ADO").

4. Purposes and Legal Basis for Processing

Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of participating in the Panek S.A. promotional campaign.

The legal basis for processing the personal data of participants in the campaign is Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR – where the legally justified interest of the administrator is to enable participation in the Campaign or to pursue and defend potential claims.

5. Period of Personal Data Processing

Your personal data will be stored for the duration of the Campaign, and after its conclusion, for a maximum period corresponding to the statute of limitations for potential claims.

6. Recipients of Data

The recipients of personal data may include:

- Entities processing data on behalf of ADO, where such entities process data as subcontractors, based on a data processing agreement and only in accordance with the instructions of ADO.
- Entities supporting ADO in its current operations by providing IT services.

7. Voluntariness of Data Provision

The provision of data is voluntary, but necessary to participate in the Campaign.

8. Rights of the Data Subjects

What rights can you exercise?

- The right to access your data and receive a copy of it in accordance with Article 15 of the GDPR.
- The right to rectify your data in accordance with Article 16 of the GDPR.
- The right to delete your data in accordance with Article 17 of the GDPR.
- The right to restrict the processing of your data in accordance with Article 18 of the GDPR.
- The right to data portability in accordance with Article 20 of the GDPR.
- The right to object to data processing in accordance with Article 21 of the GDPR.

9. Right to Lodge a Complaint with a Supervisory Authority

You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, UODO, Stawki Street 2, Warsaw.
